CDOT New Street Improvement Project

Beginning the week of May 10, 2010, construction crews will start work on a CDOT WPA Improvement Project on **N. Lister Avenue from W. Weber Avenue to N. Damen Avenue**. N. Lister Avenue will be closed to all traffic except emergency vehicles for a period of approximately sixty calendar days. Property owners are not assessed for these improvements. This project is funded entirely by the City.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Temporary "No Parking" signs will let you know when to move your vehicle
- Lister Avenue is expected to be **closed for approximately 60 days**

OVERALL PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- Full reconstruction of the roadway pavement consisting of six-inch stone sub-base, seven-inch concrete base course and three-inch asphalt overlay
- The installation of new curb and gutter and ADA accessibility ramps
- The installation of new storm water catch basins to improve drainage
- The removal and replacement of existing driveway aprons and alley returns
- The installation of new residential street lighting
- All parkways are regraded and sodded. Trees are planted at locations recommended by the City's Department of Streets and Sanitation/Bureau of Forestry
