

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The above recitals are expressly incorporated herein and made part hereof as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. The Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by creating Chapter 2-9 and adding the language underscored, as follows:

2-9-010 City Contracts

(1) Prior to final award, all contracts for goods and services in excess of \$500,000 shall be submitted by the Chief Procurement Officer to the Committee on Finance.

(2) The Committee on Finance shall have thirty (30) business days to review competitively bid contracts. The Chief Procurement Officer shall, within three (3) working days, respond to any written comments made by the Committee on Finance.

(3) The Committee on Finance shall have thirty (30) business days to review non-bid contracts. If the Committee on Finance submits written objections to a non-bid contract to the Chief Procurement Officer within ten (10) days, the Chief Procurement Officer shall withhold award of the proposed contract and either:

(a) process the contract as a competitively bid contract; or

(b) submit to the Committee on Finance, within ninety (90) days written justification for processing the contract as a non-bid contract.

(4) If the Chief Procurement Officer selects option 3 (b), the Committee on Finance shall have an additional ten (10) days to review the new submissions.

(5) If the Committee on Finance reenters its written objections to the non-bid contract during the second ten day period, the Chief Procurement Officer shall either:

(a) withdraw the proposed contract; or

(b) initiate bid proceedings for the proposed contract;

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 60 days after passage and publication.
